### Plan your trip

- Get a personalized trip plan: trip options, transfers, fares at [www.go-metro.com](http://www.go-metro.com)

### Reading your Metro schedule

- Look on map for number (timepoint) closest to your location
- Find schedule for correct day and travel direction
- Read down from timepoint and across for times
- There are bus stops between the listed timepoints
- Check notes at bottom for additional information

### Riding Metro

- Bus stops are marked with a Metro sign or orange band
- Arrive at the bus stop a few minutes early
- Route number and name are above the bus windshield
- Pay fare as you board. Most afternoon express routes, pay as you leave (ask driver)
- A block before your stop, pull cord above window to signal driver
- Traffic and weather conditions may delay buses

### Go smart on Metro

- No food, beverages or smoking on Metro
- Be considerate... no profanity or loud talking
- Offer front seats to older adults, people with disabilities
- Use headphones with audio equipment
- Keep belongings on your lap; don't use two seats
- Take everything with you when you leave
- Fold strollers and carts
- Report suspicious behavior or unattended items to the driver

### SmartCommuter

### Base fares

\$1.50 Within City of Cincinnati (zone 1)  
\$2.00 To, from or within Hamilton Co. (zone 2)  
\$2.50 To, from or within Clermont Co. & Harrison, OH (zone 3)  
\$0.50 Rt. 85 Riverfront parking shuttle

If traveling between zones, request zone ticket when paying fare

### Premium express fares

\$3.00 Rt. 42X West Chester, Rt. 62X Fairfield (zone 4)  
\$3.75 Rt. 71X/72 Kings Island (Warren Co.)

### Reduced fares

- Half-price fare on any trip
- Fare Deal ID card (65+, Medicare, or disabled)
- Access ID card (ADA-eligible only)
- Children age 5 (45") and under
- Fare Deal monthly sticker, \$32.50 (all zones)

### Transfers \$0.25

- Request transfer when paying fare
- Good on any route, any direction for limited time
- Up to two bus transfers per transfer ticket

### Monthly bus passes

\$55 Zone 1 pass  
\$75 Zone 2 pass  
\$95 Zone 3 pass (Clermont Co., Harrison, OH)  
\$115 Zone 4 pass (Butler Co.)  
\$145 All pass (all zones including Warren Co.)  
\$85 M/T pass (Metro zone 1 and TANK)

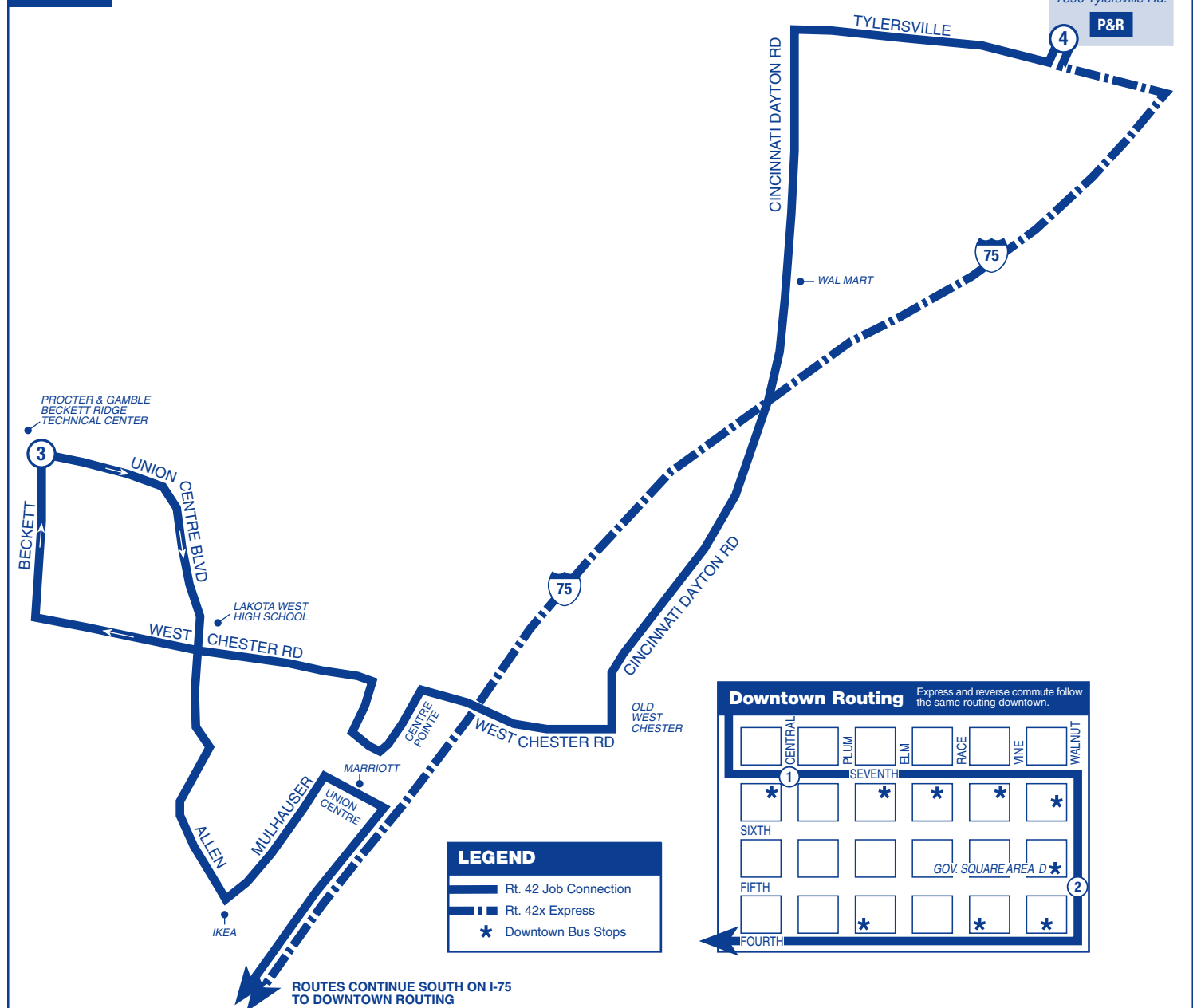
