


### Metro Park & Rides

### Metro's Guaranteed Ride Home program

Leave your worries behind. As a member of [Metro's Guaranteed Ride Home](#) program, you can be reimbursed for up to 80% of your taxi fare when you need to leave work due to an emergency, illness or unexpected overtime.

Funded through a federal grant to promote public-transit use, Metro's Guaranteed Ride Home will reimburse you up to four times per calendar year up to a maximum of \$100. The maximum for a single taxi ride is \$45. Reimbursement is made when unplanned overtime or an unexpected emergency occurs during your normal workday. Only trips from work to home, a hospital, daycare facility, school, or to a park-and-ride facility are covered. Joining is easy!
