### Government Square currently closed until Thursday, Sept. 3

Metro boarding areas A, B and C on Government Square are closed due to streetcar-related construction until Thursday, Sept. 3 at 7 a.m. All routes that normally serve these areas have been detoured to other areas, as shown below.

Areas D, E, F, G and H will remain open. Riders will still be able to access Metro's ticket vending machine and information booth.

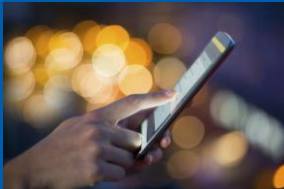
