The below express service routes will have downtown re-routing effective, Monday, March 7:

Rts. [14X](#), [15X](#), [23X](#) will be removed from Walnut St. to Race St. (morning trip) and Vine St. (afternoon trip) and will stop at Government Square Area E instead of Area D.

Rt. [30X](#) & [75X](#) based on public comment, will operate on Race St. instead of Walnut between 6th & 5th Streets.

Rt. [40X](#) will operate on Broadway instead of Main between 5th and 9th Streets and stop at Government Square Area E instead of Area G.

Rt. [67](#) will operate on Broadway instead of Main between 5th and 9th Street and stop at Government Square Area F.

Rts. [71](#) will operate on Sycamore, 4th and 5th Streets instead of

The Ohio-Kentucky-Indiana Regional Council of Governments (OKI) needs your input at its Public Meeting on specialized transportation needs. The meeting will be held on Thursday, March 10 from 2-4 p.m. at OKI's office downtown to discuss needs and suggestions for improving transportation services for individuals with special needs related to age, disabilities or limited income.

Input shared at this meeting will be used to update the region's Coordinated Plan aimed at providing transportation for older adults and individuals with disabilities where public transportation is not available or not adequate.

BE STREETCAR SAFE



Be Streetcar Safe while driving along streetcar track

With the new Cincinnati Streetcar set to go into operation later this year it is important for all motorists to be smart about driving along the Streetcar route. Here are a few safety tips:

- You can drive on the streetcar tracks, but some streetcar tracks change lanes, so don't follow the tracks.
- Streetcars cannot stop quickly or maneuver out of the way of vehicles and pedestrians, so give them lots of

space.

- Based on special signals, the streetcar may move at different times than other traffic.
- Watch for streetcars before turning.
- Park your entire vehicle within the white lines (including mirrors) and look before opening your door.
- Never block the track area.
- Do NOT drive on tracks in areas marked "Streetcar only"
