METRO DEBUTS NEW 30-DAY ROLLING PASS

Introducing Metro's new 30-day rolling pass - same zones, same prices, same unlimited rides.

Metro's 30-day rolling passes are sold by zone, and provide you with unlimited rides on any local or express Metro route for that zone. No more standing in line the first of the month or worrying about using your pass during a month when you take vacation or don't ride as often.



Instead of a monthly pass that is only valid during that calendar month, Metro's 30-day rolling pass lets you choose when to start your 30-day pass period. For example, buy a 30-day rolling pass on March 5 and it will be good until April 3. For additional information on the new 30-day rolling pass click [here](#).

Here's how it works:



The first time you use your 30-day rolling pass, insert it in the slot on top of the farebox. The farebox will print that day's date as the start date

ACCESS UNVEILS NEW VEHICLE DESIGN



Metro's Access paratransit service for people whose disabilities prevent them from riding Metro is getting new vehicles. The new vehicles will be designed to look more like Metro buses to bring them under the Metro branding guidelines. Leave your worries behind when you sign up for a Guaranteed Ride Home. As a member of Metro's Guaranteed Ride Home program you can be reimbursed for up to 80% of travel costs when you need to leave work due to an emergency, illness or unexpected overtime.



Funded though a federal grant to promote public transit use, Metro's Guaranteed Ride Home will reimburse you up to four times per calendar year at a maximum of \$45 per occurrence, \$100 per year. Reimbursement is made when unplanned overtime or an unexpected emergency occurs during your normal workday. Only trips from work to home, hospital, daycare facility, school, or to a park and ride facility are covered.
