

Summary of Inaugural Transit Infrastructure Fund Projects by Community

Addyston

- **Project description:** Pavement and curb repair and installation of a bus pad along Main St. from Dining Ln. to the western terminus to benefit riders of Metro Rts. 32 and 50.
- **Project funding:** \$227,295

Anderson

- **Project description:** Construction of new sidewalk connecting Elstun Rd. and Spindlehill Ln. residents to Metro Rts. 24 and 30X.
- **Project funding:** \$306,472

City of Cincinnati

- **Project descriptions:** Improvements to Paxton Ave. (Wasson to Marburg) including rehabilitating road pavement, sidewalks and curb ramps. Also includes safety improvements by reducing four lanes down to three to provide a center left turn lane to reduce rear end and angle crashes and Western Hills Viaduct replacement.
- **Project funding:** \$7.2 million plus \$8.2 million per year for 25 years for Western Hills Viaduct (total \$205 million)

Colerain Township

- **Project description:** Addition of four bus pull-offs along Colerain Ave. to reduce bus congestion on the busy street, while offering shelters, benches, lighting and ADA improvements for bus riders.
- **Project funding:** \$400,000

Columbia Township

- **Project description:** Widen southbound approach of Walton Creek Rd. at US 50 to Orchard St. to extend the southbound left turn bay to improve operations at US 50.
- Project funding: \$80,000



Deer Park

- Project description: Rehabilitate Plainfield Rd. including new sidewalks and curb ramps for ADA compliance.
- **Project funding:** \$680,000

<u>Delhi</u>

- **Project descriptions:** Install sidewalk along the east side of Mt. Alverno Rd. from Delhi Ave. to Paul Rd. to provide access to Metro Rt. 77. In addition, this project will install sidewalk along the east side of Neeb Rd. from Delhi Ave. to Foley Rd. to provide access to Metro Rt. 32. Finally, this project will install sidewalk along Greenwell Ave. from Mt. Alverno Rd. to Delhi Ave.
- Project funding: \$450,657

Forest Park

- **Project descriptions:** Road repairs to Winton Rd. between Kemper and West Kenn; Winton Rd. between West Sharon and West Kemper, including installing concrete bus pads, bus shelters and benches, trash receptacles and bike racks; and West Kemper installing culvert pipe and concrete parking blocks.
- **Project funding:** \$1.2 million.

Golf Manor

- **Project description:** Improvements along Wiehe Rd. including fixing deteriorating pavement, curbs, side walks, crosswalks, storm drains and replacing ADA curb ramps.
- **Project funding:** \$510,975

Green Hills

- Project description: Improvements to the Green Hills Park & Ride with increased ADA access to Metro Rt. 14X.
- Project funding: \$116,400

<u>Glendale</u>

- Project description: Traffic signal improvements at Sharon Rd. and SR 4 to facilitate traffic movement.
- **Project funding:** \$333,000

Hamilton County

- **Project descriptions:** Road and sidewalk repair in Delhi including curbing on entire length of Mt. Alverno Rd. and Pedretti Ave. from Mt. Alverno Rd. to Delhi Pk. and road and sidewalk repair in North College Hill on Simpson Ave. between North Bend Rd. and Northern Ave.
- **Project funding:** \$1.7 million

<u>Harrison</u>

- **Project description:** Street and sidewalk repair on Harrison Ave. between New Haven Rd. and Stone Rd. Smoother pavement will improve traffic safety and new curb ramps for ADA compliance and improve safety for pedestrians.
- **Project funding:** \$222,500

Lincoln Heights

- **Project description:** Reconstruction of Leggett St. & Wabash St., including making pedestrian-related improvements near Metro Rt. 78.
- **Project funding:** \$656,500



<u>Madeira</u>

- **Project description:** Revitalize Miami Avenue to provide direct connection for Metro Rt. 2 to Metro Park & Ride and to Kenwood Towne Centre, enhancing transit access and connecting to the 24-hour Metro Rt. 4.
- **Project funding:** \$3.6 million

Mt. Healthy

- **Project description:** Road and sidewalk repairs including curb ramps on Compton Rd. from Hamilton to west corporation line, improving access to Metro Rts. 16 and 17.
- Project funding: \$872,800

North College Hill

- **Project description:** Street and curb repair along Hamilton Ave. including curb ramps, improving access to riders of Metro Rt. 17
- **Project funding:** \$552,045

<u>Norwood</u>

- **Project description:** Sidewalk and street repair on Montgomery Rd. between Cleneay Ave. and Ross Ave. including bus pads, curb ramps, and pavement markings serving Metro Rts. 4 and 90.
- **Project funding:** \$765,900

Sharonville

- **Project description:** Addition of a center turn lane and sidewalk on Hauck Rd. as well as improving pedestrian and vehicular safety within the job hub.
- **Project funding:** \$268,000

Silverton

- **Project description:** Road and sidewalk repair on Plainfield Rd. from Montgomery Rd. to Diehl Ave., including curb ramps and other ADA improvements.
- **Project funding:** \$357,000

Sycamore Township

- **Project description:** Reconstructing ADA-compliant sidewalks on Montgomery Rd. and improving pedestrian connectivity and access to Metro bus stops.
- **Project funding:** \$605,097

Springdale

- **Project description:** Repair bridge crossing CSX rail line on East. Kemper Rd.
- **Project funding:** \$110,000

Wyoming

- **Project description:** Road and sidewalk repair on Compton Ave. from corporation line to corporation line. Install sidewalks between Poage Farm Rd. and Pleasant Ave.
- Project funding: \$1.0 million
